# THE LAST LAUGH

## EXT. CEMETERY - LATE AFTERNOON

Bruce Wayne stands outside of the grave of his parents. In front of him is a large tombstone that reads WAYNE.

Bruce lays 2 roses down at the bottom of the tombstone.

He looks around as the sun sets through the trees above, the snow beginning to fall.

Bruce then turns around, heading down a narrow path covered with branches and trees that head into a dark abyss of forest.

## EXT. OUTSIDE OF WAYNE MANOR/OVERLOOKING GOTHAM HARBOR

Bruce walks out of a clearing on a cliff overlooking Gotham harbor. In the distance, Gotham City is surrounded by a darkened sky, the signs of the hard times apparent.

Panning over, Wayne Manor sits on the right side of Bruce, amongst the snow.

## INT. INSIDE OF WAYNE MANOR

Bruce Wayne walks down a hallway of Wayne Manor.

ALFRED Will you be needing anything else, sir?

BRUCE WAYNE No Alfred.

ALFRED

Very Well, Master Bruce.

Bruce walks over to a grandfather clock and opens the face. He turns both hands to the 12 position and closes the face.

The clock chimes and slowly opens.

## INT. INSIDE OF BAT CAVE

Bruce Wayne emerges from a side of the Bat cave. He walks out onto a balcony overlooking a small pool of water in the cave.

The water rushes over a large waterfall into obscure darkness.

Alfred walks down the stairs.

ALFRED

Master Bruce?

BRUCE WAYNE Yes Alfred?

ALFRED

Everything alright, sir?

Alfred walks down onto the balcony looking over the cave with Bruce.

BRUCE WAYNE

Just one of those days.

ALFRED

Understandable, sir.

Bruce puts on the Batman cowl.

BATMAN

The Jokers being transferred to Arkham.

ALFRED

Strange individual isn't he?

BATMAN

He is.

ALFRED

Oh and Miss Madison called to ask about tonight's engagement at the Riveria.

BATMAN

I'll have to cancel for now.
Tell her I'll call her.

ALFRED

Yes sir.

Batman walks over to the Batmobile.

The cockpit opens.

## INT. INSIDE OF CITY HALL/HOLDING CELL - MOMENTS LATER

Gordon stands outside of the Holding cell, looking into it. Bullock walks up to him, holding a cup of coffee.

BULLOCK
Strange fella isn't
he commish?

GORDON He is.

The Joker sits in his cell, looking up at the ceiling, mumbling to himself.

Bullock walks closer to the cell. Joker looks over at him and smiles.

BULLOCK

You'll get what's comin to you clown.

Joker smiles and looks on.

Essen walks near Bullock.

Captain Collins from the Gotham SWAT walks up to Gordon.

COLLINS

Everything's ready for transfer.

Gordon hands his cigarette to Bullock.

GORDON

Alright everyone, let's get this moving.

The cell opens as two police officers, guarded under SWAT officers go in and retrieve Joker. They lead him out of the cell.

# INT. INSIDE OF CITY HALL/LOBBY - SECONDS LATER

Summer Gleason stands near a crowd of reporters. Outside of the City Hall, police officers are having a hard time trying to hold back a large mob.

The mob shouts and throws objects.

Summer looks at the cameraman.

SUMMER

How are we looking, Tommy?

TOMMY

Looking fine Miss Gleason.

Summer straightens herself.

TOMMY

Five, Four, Three, Two-

SUMMER

Good evening Gotham and welcome to a special report.

Gordon walks down the hallway, officers in tow heavily guarding the Joker who slowly shuffles along.

SUMMER

The infamous criminal known only as The Joker was apprehended last night by The Batman. Any minute we are waiting for a glimpse at the accused criminal as he is transferred temporarily to the Maximum Security wing at Arkham Asylum.

#### INT. INSIDE OF BATMOBILE - SECONDS LATER

As Batman drives the Batmobile he looks down at a small screen on his computer. Summer Gleason still talks.

SUMMER

A cloud of suspicion also still surrounds the vigilante known as The Batman who surfaced 2 months ago. Gotham Police Commissioner, Jim Gordon has faced an onslaught of criticism for not handing the situation of The Batman on the

side, often referring it to something that the Department is working on exclusively.

## INT. INSIDE OF CITY HALL/LOBBY

As Gordon comes around the corner with the other officers, surrounding Joker some of the men and women of the press as well as the mom erupt in excitement.

The members of the press flash their cameras.

SUMMER

Here comes the Joker escorted by Commissioner Gordon and his Detectives.

The camera pans on The Joker as he shuffles along smirking.

SUMMER

The Joker is clearly visible as he is being transported by the members of Gotham's Finest.

Policemen stand in front of Gleason and the rest of the men and women crowded inside the Lobby.

GORDON

I hope your happy. The whole city is out against you.

Gordon stops as The Joker walks past him.

JOKER

It's my pleasure, Commissioner.

Joker and the rest of the officers turn into another hallway out of view of the mob.

Gordon stands with a police officer and Captain Collins.

GORDON

Get West 5<sup>th</sup> cornered off so we can get through alright. I don't want any mistakes while transporting this whack job.

POLICE OFFICER Yes, sir.

COLLINS

Sir, everything is ready outside the loading doors.

GORDON

Good. Remember to follow procedure. We don't need any more trouble than what we have now. I'll be here in my office if you need anything.

COLLINS

You got it, Jim.

## EXT. OUTSIDE OF GOTHAM POLICE STATION - NIGHT

Crowds of people cram the parking lot outside of the Gotham Police Station rear.

Members of the mob shout as they try to break through the perimeters held by the police officers.

Joker is lead through a larger door.

Members of Gotham Police surround the small distance from the door to the truck as Joker is lead inside with two swat and a police officer, and Detective Bullock.

Collins stands outside the truck.

COLLINS

If that son of a bitch moves, shoot him.

SWAT 1

Yes sir.

Collins closes the door and slams his hand on the rear, giving a thumbs up.

Other police officers go to their cars as they begin to head out.

## EXT. ROOFTOP OF BUILDING

Batman sits perched on top of the building looking down at what's happening outside of the Gotham Police Department.

He takes out a pair of binoculars and looks through them.

BATMAN

They've got an decoy set up. Going North East on  $5^{\rm th}$ .

ALFRED

Yes sir.

## INT. INSIDE OF ARMORED CAR

Joker sits bobbing his head back and forth as the two SWAT members look on.

Joker twiddles his thumbs as he looks all around.

Bullock lights a cigarette.

JOKER

You know detective, I think there's something you should know.

BULLOCK

Pipe down clown. We don't want to hear anymore crap from you.

JOKER

Oh, alright. I just thought you would like to know about the missing babies.

The men look at the Joker.

JOKER

If they die, then it's your loss.

Bullock grabs phone.

BULLOCK

Jim? Something's up. I'll
 put you on speaker.

Bullock puts the cell phone on speaker phone.

GORDON
Go ahead.

JOKER

Commissioner I know we've had a little spat the past few days and you caught me fair and square but I think you should know about the missing children.

GORDON

What missing children?

JOKER

The Newbury Orphanage, Lower West side. You've probably never heard of it because you probably don't care. It's a real shame.

## EXT. ROOFTOP OF BUILDING

Batman listens in onto the conversation, hearing it in his earpiece.

JOKER

I don't need to tell you the address because I'm sure you can find it on your own, but you have exactly 2 hours,

until midnight. Or the children die.

GORDON

Where are they Joker.

**JOKER** 

That's where the fun begins. you will have to figure that all out by yourself. You and The Batman.

Gordon sits by his desk. Stunned.

JOKER

The game begins now, Commissioner.

Joker sits back in the Truck.

Bullock drops his cell phone on the floor of the truck. Suddenly the Gotham Police Officer bashes Bullock over the head with his pistol.

The police officer quickly turns shooting both of the SWAT officers in the head.

Joker sits there silently.

POLICE OFFICER
I need immediate assistance.
Copy.

The hatch from the front of the truck opens.

DRIVER

What the hell happened?

POLICE OFFICER

The Joker tried to rush us, we need the backed open immediately.

The truck comes to a halt. The police officer reaches over, uncuffing Joker.

The Officer hands Joker a larger pistol from underneath his shirt.

The doors of the truck open.

The officer, who is Jokers goon shoots the SWAT officer in the head.

# EXT. ROOFTOP OF BUILDING

Batman rushes back, off into the distance.

## INT. INSIDE OF GORDONS OFFICE

Gordon rushes out of his office

## EXT. GOTHAM STREET - MOMENTS LATER

Police Officers rush into the scene. Gordon pulls up, running towards the armored car with Captain Collins.

Bullock is helped up.

GORDON

What the hell happened?

BULLOCK

That city cop was in with that freak.

Bullock rubs his head in pain.

COLLINS

I want any officer that is off duty or off patrol here now. I need an immediate sweep of the area.

Gordon walks towards the back of the truck, looking inside at the two dead SWAT officers.

He turns around to see Batman standing there.

Everyone else is silent.

BULLOCK

What are you doing here? Some one arrest him!

GORDON

No.

Everyone looks at Gordon.

BATMAN

Joker was last heading due east

through the alleyway here. I can help.

Gordon looks around at the other officers.

GORDON

How was he able to do all this?

BATMAN

Whoever was working with him must have been connected with your department somehow.

GORDON

But that's not possible.

BATMAN

If it wasn't possible, it wouldn't have happened. Conduct your investigation, and I'll do mine.

Gordon looks at Bullock. As he looks back, Batman is gone.

GORDON

We have to get everyone together immediately. Get me Essen and the rest of Major Crimes.

BULLOCK

You got it commish.

## EXT. OUTSIDE OF NEWBURY ORPHANAGE - MOMENTS LATER

Batman arrives outside of the orphanage.

Batman presses into his headset.

BATMAN

Gordon.

Gordon walks around outside the police cars and hears his radio.

GORDON

Go ahead.

BATMAN

I'm outside the Orphanage. If I find anything I'll let you know. GORDON Alright.

# INT. INSIDE OF NEWBURY ORPHANAGE/ROOM

Batman walks around inside one of the old rooms. As he goes through the old room he notices a card on the floor.

The card is from the GOTHAM ACE PLAYING CARD CO.

On the back of the card is a phone number.

BATMAN Alfred.

ALFRED
Yes Master Bruce.

BATMAN

I need you to analyze a number for me. 459-1291.

ALFRED Yes sir.

Batman stops and looks out the window. A small man dressed in biker apparel is sneaking around outside.

Batman moves into the shadows.

The goon walks through the entrance into the Orphanage.

He walks into the room and begins to look around all over the floor.

JOHNNY

Damn it, where did it go?

BATMAN

Looking for this?

Johnny turns around to see Batman holding the card.

JOHNNY

What are you doing here?

Johnny tries to pull out his gun, But Batman lunges forward, throwing him up against the wall.

BATMAN

Where is he?

JOHNNY

I don't know what your talking about man.

BATMAN

The Joker. I want him.

## INT. INSIDE OF GORDONS OFFICE

Gordon listens to a voice on the other end of the phone.

GORDON

Great, I'll get right on it.

ESSEN

What is it?

Gordon motions to Essen to hold on.

GORDON

You got it. Bye.

Gordon puts down the phone.

GORDON

There's a verbal dispute at Gotham Square apartments. I need you to run over and settle it while I get this going.

ESSEN

Alright.

Essen walks around the corner of Gordon's desk and kisses him o the cheek.

ESSEN

I'll see you in a little bit.

GORDON

I'll see you.

Essen exits Gordon's office.

INT. INSIDE OF NEWBURY ORPHANAGE/ROOM - SECONDS LATER

Batman throws the goon to the ground.

BATMAN

I want him! (Yelling)

Now!

The goon starts to cough up a little blood. He holds out his hand.

JOHNNY
Alright. I'll tell
you.

Batman looks on.

EXT. GOTHAM CITY - NIGHT

The Bat Signal appears in the night sky.

## EXT. TOP OF GOTHAM POLICE DEPARTMENT

Commissioner Gordon stands next to the Bat Signal, with a cup of coffee in hand, cigarette in his mouth.

Harvey Bullock eats a doughnut, looking into the night.

BATMAN

What's the news.

Gordon and Bullock turn around.

Bullock hands Batman a set of pictures.

Batman looks at them.

BATMAN

The children.

GORDON

Exactly.

BATMAN

How is it that this wasn't known.

GORDON

The Newbury Orphanage has always been on the mobs payroll. When someone gets a child, they receive a profit.

BULLOCK 15,000 per child GORDON

However. Things are slowly coming together. We've only got about a half hour until he plans to kill the children.

BATMAN

Where's Detective Essen?

GORDON

She responded to a domestic dispute while I finished some stuff around Here.

BATMAN

I know where the Joker is.

GORDON

Where is he?

BATMAN

825, Gotham Square Apartments.

Gordon looks in disbelief at Batman.

GORDON

Oh my god.

BATMAN

What?

GORDON

That's where Sarah is.

## INT. INSIDE OF APARTMENT HALLWAY - MOMENTS LATER

Essen walks over to a door that reads 825.

She takes a pick and unlocks the door, walking inside.

# INT. INSIDE OF APARTMENT 825

Essen walks into the living room of the apartment which is pitch black.

In a room off to the side, the sound of a crying infant is heard. Essen turns off her radio on her waist, and draws her pistol.

She turns the light on in the bedroom to find the room with a couple of infants.

## INT. INSIDE OF APARTMENT 825

Essen walks around the children. As she leans down, there's noise coming from the hallway.

The sound of an echo of a laugh is heard.

Essen runs out of the bedroom, but in the doorway of the apartment stands, The Joker.

JOKER

Well. Well. Detective.

The Joker claps his hands, and the lights come up. Two of his henchmen walk in behind him.

ESSEN

You set this up.

JOKER

Pretty much.

ESSEN

What's the motive?

The Joker smiles, running his fingers through his hair.

JOKER

That's the Punch line, my Dear. There is no motive.

ESSEN

What do you mean?

Essen is becoming slightly alarmed.

JOKER

Have you ever had an infant Near you, and they start Crying? (Pause) And then you Want to rip their head off?

Joker grabs a small toy baby and holds it.

He clenches his hands around the dolls neck. His grip becomes tighter.

JOKER (Cont.)

They start crying. Mommy! Mommy! And then-

Joker tears the head off the doll, throwing it against the wall.

JOKER (Cont.)

You rip them apart! (Laughs)

Essen becomes enraged, backing up towards the entrance of the bedroom full of children.

ESSEN

Your mad.

JOKER

No, not really. I'm quite Content at the moment.

Essen tries to aim her pistol, but Joker takes out his first, aiming it at her.

JOKER

You're going to have to move Detective. The children's time Has run out. It is almost midnight.

**ESSEN** 

Over my dead body.

JOKER

Oh. You want to play that game?
Well I'll give you a choice.
Either you move, or I'll
Shoot you. And I'll move you
Myself.

Essen looks at Joker, defiantly.

Joker rolls his eyes.

JOKER Alright then.

Joker aims his pistol and fires.

Essen's stomach explodes as she falls to the floor. She gasps for air.

Joker hops over her, kneeling down next to her.

JOKER

I asked you nicely to move.
And unfortunately you didn't
Want to follow my rules.
Do you want to see a cool
Trick?

Joker takes the pistol, and puts it in his mouth.

He pulls the trigger. Click. The barrel is empty. Joker laughs hysterically.

Essen looks up at Joker.

Joker starts to unbutton Essen's blouse. He runs his hand around the wound near her stomach. Blood slowly seeps out.

Joker smiles the whole time.

ESSEN

You child murderer.

JOKER

Oh I've changed my mind. I'm
Not going to murder the children
Anymore. The thought is just
Boring. I have a better idea.

# INT. INSIDE OF BATMOBILE - SECONDS LATER

On the screen of the Batmobile shows Jokers face.

JOKER

Hello Batman. Long time No see.

BATMAN

What's your plan Joker.

JOKER

Well now, bats. You know That it wouldn't be much Fun to spoil the surprise!

BATMAN

I'm amused.

JOKER

Not yet you won't be. But I've got something you'll Love.

BATMAN

And what's that?

JOKER

You'll have to find me.
To find out what it is.
(laughs) I see that you've
Already found out where the
Kiddies are. Now it's up to
You to figure the rest out.

The screen goes to black. A light blinks near the steering wheel. Batman presses it.

BATMAN
Yes Alfred.

ALFRED

Sir, Wayne Securities has Been notified of a break in Near the Gotham Chemical plant.

# INT. INSIDE APARTMENT 825 - MOMENTS LATER

Gordon walks through the doorway, drawn.

Officers follow behind him, closely, with their guns drawn as well. Awaiting anything that moves.

OFFICER 1 Commissioner?

Gordon looks back at the officer. He points to the carpet just underneath Gordon's foot.

OFFICER 1
There's blood sir.

Gordon looks down at the carpet and see's blood stains all over the carpet.

GORDON

File out. Check every room.

The Officers look around slowly, stunned at the chaos.

GORDON

(Yelling) Now!

The officers move about. Bullock enters with another police officer.

BULLOCK

What's going on Commish'?

GORDON

Essen's missing.

Officer Two comes from one of the adjoining rooms.

OFFICER TWO

Commissioner, The bedroom has the missing infants.

Gordon sees that the Officer is a bit terrified. And nervous.

GORDON

What is it?

OFFICER TWO

Sir, they're covered in blood.

Gordon rushes into the bedroom and looks at some of the babies. Although they have spots of blood on them, they are not injured.

BULLOCK

It's not their blood.

Gordon stands up. He walks to Officer Two.

GORDON

Put a bulletin out. Detective Essen is missing. I want all available units now.

Gordon looks towards the wall. Joker has taken his finger and written in Essen 's Blood. The blood has formed the bat symbol with a lot of Ha-ha's all over.

BATMAN (O.S.)

She's been kidnapped by The Joker.

GORDON

It was a trap. The whole thing. He set us up the whole time.

COLLINS

Commissioner. The men want to know what the circumstances are if they cross paths with the Joker.

GORDON

I want him alive.

Gordon and the other officers look toward the open bay windows. Batman stands with the silhouette of the city behind him.

BATMAN (Cont.)

He needs to be stopped.

BULLOCK

What are you going to do about it Bats? (Sarcastically)

Gordon looks at Bullock, who in returns shrugs his shoulders.

Montoya rushes into the apartment.

MONTOYA

Officers reported a stolen Air Ship flying near Gotham Chemical.

Gordon looks at Montoya.

GORDON

We have to get that Airship.

Batman, can you -

Gordon turns around but see's that Batman is gone.

# EXT. GOTHAM SQUARE APARTMENTS - SECONDS LATER

Gordon's and others race out of the building, jumping into their respective cars.

The cars speed through the street, sirens blaring.

## INT. INSIDE GORDONS CAR

Inside Gordon's car, sits Gordon and Montoya. Gordon grabs the Radio.

GORDON

I need all available units to converge upon Gotham Chemical. Immediately.

MONTOYA
Oh my god.

GORDON What?

MONTOYA Look.

Montoya points ahead at an enormous Air Ship, suspended in the sky over Gotham Chemical. The bright red neon letters of Gotham Chemical can be seen glowing against the blood red sky.

BATMAN (Radio)
Gordon.

GORDON Go ahead.

### EXT. OUTSIDE OF GOTHAM CHEMICAL

The Batmobile arrives up in front of Gotham Chemical. Batman jumps out and looks up at the large airship. On the side of the Air Ship, The Joker the Joker has spray painted "HaHaHaHa" on the side in bright red spray-paint.

Batman speaks into the radio on his belt.

BATMAN

I've reached the factory.

Batman runs through the front doors of the factory.

## INT. INSIDE OF AIRSHIP CONTROL STATION - SECONDS LATER

The Joker stands in front of the Control Station. A goon walks up behind him.

CURLS

Boss. The Batman's down there.

Joker turns around, looking at the thugs.

JOKER

Oh happy day. Tell me boys, do you like bats?

An enormous goon on the right of Curls, MO, shakes his head "no".

JOKER

Great! (Throws hands out) Let's have a festival Boys!

## EXT. ON TOP OF GOTHAM CHEMICAL ROOF

Batman races towards the rope ladder hanging from the Airship.

Suddenly he is tackled to the ground by Mo.

Mo punches Batman in his jaw. Batman repels back, kicking Mo in the chest.

Mo lands feet away.

Batman stands up quickly, Curls runs at Batman. He lurches forward, trying to strike Batman, But Batman moves in and out. He leans over, punching Curls in his stomach. As Curls keels over Batman brings his fists down on top of him.

Above, Joker leans out of the doorway looking down.

JOKER

Ouch. That'll leave a mark. (Chuckles)

## INT. BAY OF AIRSHIP CONTROL STATION

Joker's goons around him hold machine guns.

Joker leans back in and looks over at Mayor Hill, who is tied up against a steel girder. Joker kneels down next to him. Joker removes Hill's blind fold.

JOKER

Peek A Boo!

Hill squirms in anguish, with a terrified look in his eyes. Joker's face becomes contorted.

JOKER

Oh? What is that Hamilton?
I'm sorry but your voice.
I can't hear you. Oh I have
an idea.

Joker rips off Hill's tape from his mouth.

JOKER

There. That's sensible.

MAYOR HILL

Let us go now! (Yelling)

Joker PUNCHES Hill in the face.

JOKER

Chuckles!

A goon runs up to him.

CHUCKLES
Yes, boss?

THE JOKER
Start the ride. We're goin to have an Air show.

Hill looks confused.

MAYOR HILL Air show?

Joker kneels down next to Hill.

JOKER

Oh yes Mayor. An Air show. When we get to our altitude Of 5,000 feet, that's when the fun really begins.

MAYOR HILL What fun?

JOKER

First we drop Miss Essen off right over Gordon's Apartment.

Joker points his gun to her body. He pulls the trigger. BLAM! Joker sort of shakes, as if not expecting it.

JOKER

Oops. Oh well, She was already dead.

MAYOR HILL Your mad!

JOKER

No. No. I'm crazy. You see. The blood from her body will be all (Prolonged) Over the building. Then it's your turn. You my little lamb are special to me.

MAYOR HILL What are you going to do?

JOKER

Oh. Just wait and see.

Joker stands up and walks down the walkway. He walks over to the window and looks down.

The Air Ship floats into the night sky. Getting higher and higher.

Batman battles Mo as he puts a headlock on him. Batman flips him over his shoulder and Slams his fist into Mo's face.

Batman looks up and produces his Bat Grapple. The Bat Grapple extends onto the Rope. Batman launches off into the air.

Tiny looks over the open door down to see Batman climbing up the rope towards the cabin.

TINY (Yelling)
Boss!

Joker is kneeling down in front of Julie Madison. Talking to her.

JOKER

What do you want Tiny?

TINY

You gotta come see this.

JOKER

Not now. I'm busy with Miss Madison.

TINY

But Boss -

JOKER

I don't know what's so
 important.

BATMAN

Me.

Joker's eyes light up. And he turns around to see Batman standing at the end of the cabin.

JOKER
I knew you'd come (Smiling)

BATMAN Let them go, Joker.

JOKER
Uh. I can't.

Batman starts to walk toward The Joker slowly. Joker grabs Essen's body and holds it next to the open area of the cabin. Outside nothing is visible except the dim view of the Gotham City lights. The clouds are visible outside as air pours in.

Batman stops.

JOKER

We know you're capable of saving one. But. How about a couple?

Joker lets go of Essen's body.

Batman rushes towards the opening about to go after her body, but it disappears outside.

Batman starts to walk towards Joker again.

JOKER

Who cares, right? She was dead to begin with (Laughs)

The Joker grabs Councilman Timm.

JOKER

Lets tell a little secret here.

Mister Timm here suffers from
Bipolar disorder and is afraid

Of clowns.

Joker taunts Batman by leaning in and out while holding Timm

over the sky. The Joker releases Timm and kicks Mayor Hill.

Both men fall from the Air ship. Batman dives through the air. He catches Timm in his arms and ties him around his waist. He also grabs Hill and bat grapples onto the cab of the Air Ship.

BATMAN(Into Radio)
Gordon.

### INT. INSIDE OF GORDONS CAR

GORDON Go ahead.

BATMAN (Radio)
Send units to the Gotham
Docks. Next to the Wayne
Technologies Warehouse.

## EXT. OUTSIDE OF AIRSHIP

As the anchor of the grapple clamps onto the Air Ship the whole airborne balloon shifts to the side.

Joker falls to the floor.

JOKER

Excuse me Ladies and Gentlemen. We're going to have a bit of turbulence.

Batman repels up with the men and lands underneath the Air Ship he flies through the air and lands through the back of the cabin.

Joker looks back behind him. Batman releases Hill and Timm onto the floor.

BATMAN Stay here.

The Joker pulls out a pistol and aims it at Julie Madison. He also pulls out a small file folder from his coat.

JOKER
I've got something better for you.

Batman stops.

JOKER

I've got Miss Madison's

(Trying not to laugh)

Batman looks at Julie.

Julia turns her head afraid and starts to sob.

BATMAN What's the punch line?

JOKER

C'mon Bats. I thought you of all people would be smarter. She's pregnant!

Joker takes his pistol and aims it against her stomach and pulls the trigger.

Julie's body shifts violently and she screams out loud. Joker stands up, laughing.

Batman becomes enraged.

Batman lunches forward. Joker turns as Batman grabs Joker. Batman head butts Joker in the face. Joker slams onto the ground.

Joker grunts in pain.

Batman grabs Joker and throws him across the Open Bay.

Joker stands up, trying to gain his balance.

Batman walks over and uppercuts him in his jaw, knocking Joker to the ground again.

JOKER

You know I'm getting quite a thrill for this.

Batman picks Joker up.

JOKER

Tell me Batman, do you like flowers?

Joker takes hold of the flower on his lapel of his suit coat and sprays Batman.

Batman walks backward trying to get the spray out of his eyes.

Joker takes a metal pole and connects it into Batman's neck, knocking him to the ground.

He starts beating Batman over and over, Batman finally kicks Joker to the ground.

## EXT. GOTHAM DOCKS - MINUTES LATER

Gordon and the rest of the police arrive at the docks next to the Wayne Technologies Warehouse.

Gordon gets out, looking at the Air Ship above him.

GORDON

Everyone spread out.

Bullock walks next to him.

## INT. INSIDE OF OPEN BAY

Joker pulls out a knife from his.

JOKER

You know. I'm your biggest fan.

BATMAN

It's over Joker. Give

Up.

JOKER

My dear delusional Dark

Batman stands over Joker. Batman turns Joker around.

Quickly Joker stabs Batman in the shoulder. Batman yields and falls back in pain. Joker slashes madly towards Batman.

Batman falls back, bleeding.

JOKER

You act like you haven't felt pain before, Batman.
I bet you have. In fact,
I bet this isn't the first time you've felt true pain.

Joker stands up.

Batman takes out a batarang and throws it at The Jokers wrist. Joker falls to the ground.

Batman slowly gets up. Joker grabs the batarang and throws it toward Batman, hitting the electric control box. The lights flicker off and on inside the open bay.

Suddenly an fire begins to ensue above the pipes above them.

Batman crawls to Julie as she lies on the ground. She looks at Batman, crying.

BATMAN

It'll be ok. Stay with Me.

Batman grabs Julie and holds her against him. Joker stands up, holding a metal pipe in his hand. He stands over Batman.

He brings down the pipe on Batman's back. Batman crumples to the ground, still holding Julie.

Joker raises the bar again, but Batman turns around, slamming his fist into Joker's stomach.

Joker falls to the ground, rolling on the floor.

JOKER

Gotham Bridge is falling down, Falling down, falling down, Gotham Bridge is falling down. That stupid city.

The Blimp flies towards the end of Gotham, heading out into the open water of Gotham Bay.

JOKER (Cont.)

Julie Madison's bleeding out bleeding out, bleeding out. Julie Madison's bleeding out bleeding out, bleeding out. That poor poor lady (Laughs)

Batman gets up and walks over to Joker. He grabs Joker violently. Joker looks at Batman, smiling.

BATMAN

What's your plan? Why Kidnap these people?

JOKER

Plan? Heh. You think I
Have a plan? I don't plan
because it always flubs
Out. I just go with the
Flow.

Batman looks at Joker.

JOKER

Now kidnapping everyone Else. Well I don't know Why I did. Just sounded Like a good idea and all But then it got boring.

> BATMAN Your done.

> > JOKER

Not yet. Can you imagine How crazy Gordon will go Knowing I killed his young Striping lady? (Laughs) And what is more funny is I shot her in front of those Kids! (Laughs)

BATMAN What's the joke?

JOKER

The joke chum, is that it only takes one bad day to Make someone insane.

Batman holds onto Joker as a huge fire blazes in the background.

JOKER

I have another surprise.
The tanks will go off any
Minute and release all this
Wonderful Joker toxin into
The city. You people need
To loosen up.

Batman lays Joker out onto the ground. He slams his fist into Joker's face again. He stops and hits him again. And again. And again.

He throws Joker across the room towards the wall of the open bay.

Batman walks towards him as Joker pulls out a small remote.

JOKER

Have a blast.

The Joker pushes the button on the remote.

The whole side walk explodes. The Airship rocks to the left, in flames.

Batman grabs Julie and holds her against a couple of boxes safely.

Joker slides over the side of the floor, hanging in mid air, laughing. Batman looks over and slowly inches towards Joker.

BATMAN

Give me your hand.

JOKER

I think I'll pass Batman.
I'm just "hanging" around.

Batman looks down. There is nothing except fog.

Joker's hand slips.

BATMAN

You're slipping.

Batman outstretches his hand.

BATMAN (Cont.)

Give me your hand.

Joker lifts his free hand up towards Batman. On his hand, Joker has a buzzer.

As Batman's hand encompasses Jokers, Batman is suddenly electrocuted.

Batman yields back onto the floor, shocked.

Joker lets go, laughing, and disappears into the fog. Batman gets up and rushes over to the side. The Joker's laugh can be heard echoing through the night sky.

Batman rushes over to Mayor Hill and Councilman Timm. He hands them air masks.

MAYOR HILL What's this for?

BATMAN

We're heading for the river.

Batman looks out over the water.

BATMAN

Can you swim?

Both nod yes.

BATMAN

We're low enough. Jump. Gordon has men near the

Dock who will pick you up.

Hill leans over the side and disappears. Timm also looks over the side and jumps.

Batman crawls over to Julie and grabs hold onto her.

An electrical box above them explodes and the lights go out. Batman ends up falling over to the edge of the blimp.

He tries to hang on but loses his grip, falling through the fog into the abyss.

### EXT. GOTHAM DOCKS - MOMENTS LATER

Gordon and the rest of the officers look up at the sky. Suddenly, the Airship explodes. The other officers duck for cover.

Gordon looks to the river.

GORDON

Get some men out there!

Officers scramble on the dock.

Pieces of debris fly all over the dock.

Gordon, kneeling down behind a police car Radios for help.

GORDON

I'm going to need some medical
assistance at the old Gotham
 dockside immediately.

### EXT. GOTHAM RIVER - MINUTES LATER

Gordon stands on a boat in the river with Bullock and  $\sin x$  officers. They look around. Bullock has a flashlight and  $\sec' s$  something in the water.

BULLOCK Over there!

They spot Mayor Hill hanging onto a piece of the wreckage.

The boat crawls up alongside Hill, and Bullock and the officers

pull him inside.

## EXT. OUTSIDE OF WAREHOUSE - AN HOUR LATER

Gordon stands around, looking curiously.

Bullock walks up to Gordon.

BULLOCK

Hey commish you alright?

GORDON

Where's Batman

Montoya, standing off to the side looks at Gordon. Gordon takes out his radio, yelling into it.

GORDON

Batman.

There is silence.

GORDON (Cont.)

This is Gordon.

Still silence.

Gordon throws the radio into the water, frustrated. But looking over to the side of the dock, Gordon notices someone crawling out of the water.

He starts running for the person crawling. Bullock and other officers run behind him.

Batman crawls to the shoreline, gasping for air. His suit is entirely torn, and he is bleeding.

Gordon rushes down the rocky embankment, helping Batman get out of the water.

GORDON

We got to get you medical attention, fast.

BATMAN

I don't need it.

GORDON

But you have to-

BATMAN

I'll be fine Jim.

Gordon helps Batman stand up. He wearily looks towards the harbor.

GORDON

Where's Essen?

Batman looks at Gordon, emotionless.

The rest of the police officers look on. Captain Collins looks down at the ground.

BATMAN

She's gone. Joker pushed her body out not soon after he took off.

Gordon looks down at the ground. Empty.

BATMAN

I'm sorry Jim.

Montoya walks up to Gordon.

MONTOYA

Commissioner, All persons are present and accounted for.

Batman looks at Montoya.

BATMAN

What about Julie Madison?

GORDON

You mean Julie Madison the actress?

Batman looks at Gordon.

BATMAN

Yes.

Gordon looks at Montoya.

GORDON

We'll have to add Miss Madison to the list. Get another crew to go search for her body.

Batman walks up the embankment.

BATMAN

I'll be in touch.

Gordon stands alone on the bank of the Gotham River, with the other officers around him.

He looks down at the water as the camera pulls back.

## FADE TO:

### BLACK

### INT. INSIDE OF BRUCE WAYNES LIBRARY - MORNING

Bruce sits in his chair, reading a book, when the television comes on.

Summer Gleason stands on the edge of the Gotham Dock.

SUMMER

Good morning Gotham. Summer Gleason here with a special report.

Alfred enters the room with a tray carrying the morning paper and a glass of orange juice.

SUMMER(Cont.)

This morning Commissioner James Gordon confirmed that a week after Joker's foiled plot on Gotham City, that the search for actress, Julie Madison has been called off.

Bruce stands up.

Alfred stands there silently, watching Bruce.

SUMMER (Cont.)

Commissioner Gordon cited that
The criminal mastermind known
as the Joker also is missing and
presumed to be dead.

Bruce turns the television off.

ALFRED

Your morning paper sir.

Bruce turns around, taking the newspaper off the tray as well as the cup of orange juice.

BRUCE

She's gone, Alfred.

ALFRED

I'm sorry sir.

Bruce hands Alfred the cup of orange juice and walks away down the hallway.

### INT. INSIDE OF GORDONS OFFICE - NIGHT

Gordon sits behind his desk reading the newspaper. In the corner is the obituary column listing a column section for Sarah Essen.

Gordon takes a sip from his coffee.

There's a knock on his door.

GORDON

Come in.

Montoya enters with three policemen.

MONTOYA

These patrolmen wants to speak with you.

Gordon takes off his glasses, rubbing his eyes.

GORDON

That's fine.

Montoya walks out of the room, closing the door behind her.

GORDON

How can I help you?

PATROLMAN 1

Sir it's about last week. When the Joker kidnapped The Mayor and-

GORDON

killed Detective Essen and the actress Julie Madison. What about it?

One of the patrolmen from behind speaks up.

**JOKER** 

I wanted you to know that I wasn't able to finish what I had planned.

Gordon quickly stands up to try to aim his gun but Joker pulls out his.

Gordon freezes in his tracks.

GORDON

What do you want?

JOKER

To burn Gotham to the ground.

Joker is dressed in a Gotham Police Officer uniform, with skin tone.

He pulls out his knife holding it to Gordon's cheeks.

JOKER

I think you need to smile more.

But I want something.

GORDON

What do you want?

Joker

I want. The Batman.

The Joker smiles.

# EXT. ROOFTOP - HOURS LATER

Bullock stands on the rooftop with Montoya in the rain. Bullock puffs on cigar.

Bullock turns to one of the officers.

BULLOCK

Turn that off, He ain't comin.

One of the officers goes to turn the signal off.

BATMAN

Where's Gordon.

Bullock and Montoya turn to Batman.

THE END
